

PE & Sport Funding

Background:

The government is providing additional funding for schools in order to improve PE and sport provision in schools.

PE and sport play an extremely important part in the life of our school. We know that through PE and sports participation, children build key life skills such as team work, co-operation, self-esteem and kindness for themselves and others. We also wish to promote healthier life styles among our children.

PE is part of this year's School Improvement Plan as we realise that developing the whole child through sport is as important as developing high academic standards. Furthermore, we share the government's vision to build on the legacy from the London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games. We have so far been allocated £8,582 (up until March 2015) and will be receiving further funding in the next financial year.
